FLIGHT TRAINING AGREEMENT

Terms and Conditions

Agreement

I, _____ (“Student”) desire to obtain helicopter pilot training from Tallahassee Helicopter, LLC (“THL”) and THL desires to provide helicopter pilot training to Student under the terms and conditions set forth below. This Flight Training Agreement and any special instructions, terms and conditions, rules and regulations and procedures referenced within this Flight Training Agreement represent a single agreement and shall be referred to below as “Agreement”.

Financial Obligations

1. Student agrees to establish an account with THL and to deposit the amount of at least \$3,000.00 prior to the commencement of the training. If Student pre-purchases a training package for the purpose of enjoying the “Discounted R44 Rental Rate” listed on page 1 under “Enrollment Information - Pre-Purchased Training Package”, then Student shall deposit the amount listed on page 1 under “Enrollment Information - Pre-Purchased Training Package” prior to training commencement.
2. THL will debit Student’s account with all charges for services received and products purchased.
3. Student understands that Student must maintain a positive balance of at least \$1,000.00 at all times. If Student’s balance falls below \$1,000.00, Student will not be able to continue flight training until Student deposits additional funds.
4. If for any reason Student’s balance becomes negative and THL informs Student of the negative account balance and If Student’s balance remains negative for more than 10 calendar days, then Student hereby agrees to pay a “Negative Balance Fee” in the amount of \$10 per day for each day Student’s balance remains below \$0.00.
5. All deposits for a Student training account should be in form of a US-Dollar check or cash. Deposits via credit card are subject to a 3.0% credit card charge, which brings our published discounted, cash/check prices back to their undiscounted prices.
6. If Student makes a payment by check and Student’s check payment is returned due to insufficient funds, Student shall pay to THL an NSF charge in the amount of \$35.
7. If Student receives an access card to THL’s office, THL will debit Student’s account with a security deposit in the amount of \$35. If Student receives a TLH ramp access ID card, Tallahassee Helicopters will debit Student’s account with a security deposit in the amount of \$80. The deposits are being returned to the Student when Student returns the respective card to THL.
8. Student agrees to pay a non-refundable, one-time, administrative fee in the amount of \$125 for each single training course (Private, IFR, Commercial, CFI, CFII, ATP, Time building) or a total of \$300 for at least three single training courses) at the time of enrollment into the Training Program(s).
9. Student shall be required to pay THL for all products purchased and services received including time charges, no-show/late fees as applicable and computed at the published rates (<http://tallahassee-helicopters.com/PriceList.php>) at the time of purchase/service.
10. For Student solo flights:
 - a. Student agrees to observe and comply with all Federal Aviation Regulations, the guidelines prescribed by the Aeronautical Information Manual, the procedures outlined in Tallahassee Helicopter’s Safety Procedures & Practices Manual, and the terms of this Flight Training Agreement.
 - b. Student agrees to be the only occupant in the helicopter, i.e. there are no passengers allowed during solo flights.
 - c. Student agrees to return the aircraft at the agreed time, weather permitting. In the event of a delay, Student must notify THL as soon as practicable of the delay.

- d. Student agrees that if the aircraft must be abandoned at any location other than KTLH due to weather or other causes, Student shall pay all expenses incurred in returning the aircraft to KTLH.
 - e. Student agrees to pay all fines, penalties, forfeitures, court costs, and other expenses for parking, landing fees or other legal violations assessed against THL resulting from Student's use of the aircraft.
 - f. THL will reimburse Student for fuel purchases during cross country flights at rates not to exceed the published price for 100LL at the Quincy airport (2J9) or the published price for JET-A at the Bainbridge airport (BGE) as applicable at the time of fueling.
 - g. Student hereby expressly acknowledges and binds Student, Student's heirs and assigns for all liabilities to pay THL the sum equal to the cost of all damages to the aircraft, or loss of equipment of the aircraft during the rental period as well as any damages to their persons or property caused in whole or in part by failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the FAA, the terms of this agreement, the procedures outlined in Tallahassee Helicopter's Safety Procedures & Practices Manual, the procedures outlined in the Aeronautical Information Manual, or by any negligence of Student.
 - h. Student understands that THL's insurance does not cover the Student. Student is responsible for any damage caused by Student's negligence or failure to comply with this agreement. The student shall accept full financial responsibility for the deductible portion of an insurance claim in the event of any damage attributed to (at least in part) pilot error.
11. Student agrees to pay all of THL's costs and agrees to pay all other reasonable attorney's fees incurred by THL arising out of, or in any way connected with the enforcement of the terms or conditions of this Agreement.

Release and Hold Harmless

1. Student hereby affirms that Student is aware that flying and activities associated with flying have inherent and unforeseeable risks, which may result in serious injury or death. Student understands and agrees that neither Student's instructors nor THL, nor its employees, officers, agents, contractors, or assigns, (hereafter referred to as "Released Parties") may be held liable or responsible in any way for any injury, death, or other damages to Student, Student's family, estate, heirs or assigns that may occur as a result of Student's participation in piloting aircrafts, flying in aircrafts, receiving or giving flight instruction, aircraft rental, aircraft operations, ramp operations, or any associated activities involved with these activities, (hereafter referred to as "Flight Activities"), or as a result of the negligence of any party, including the Released Parties, whether passive or active.
2. In consideration of being allowed to participate in Flight Activities, Student hereby personally assumes all risks of Flight Activities, whether foreseen or unforeseen, that may befall Student while participating in these activities. Student further releases, exempts, and holds harmless the Released Parties from any claim or lawsuit by Student, Student's family, estate, heirs, or assigns, arising out of Student's participation in Flight Activities including both claims arising during any course of training or after Student receives any pilot certification(s).
3. Student understands that Flight Activities are physically demanding and that Student must seek the ongoing care of a licensed and authorized FAA Aviation Medical Examiner and that Student will not hold Released Parties responsible for events resulting from Student's physical condition, limitations, or incapacitation.
4. In no event will THL be liable for incidental or consequential damages, whether or not they are foreseeable.

Termination Rights

1. Student may cancel Student's enrollment at any time if Student is not in default with any of Student's responsibilities or obligations. Upon cancellation or upon the completion of the Training Program, Tallahassee Helicopters shall return to Student any remaining balance in Student's account within 60 days.
2. If Student trained at discounted rates as a result of pre-purchasing one or more training package(s), if applicable, and if Student does not complete that training program, regardless of reasons, all of Student's training time shall be retroactively reassessed at the regular, non-discounted rates.



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3. Upon Student's successful completion of the full Career Training Program at THL, if applicable, Student will have obtained at least 200 hours of flight time experience, five FAA helicopter pilot certificates and ratings (Private, Instrument, Commercial, Flight Instructor, Instrument Instructor), and will have demonstrated that Student possess the attitude and professionalism to work as a commercial pilot and flight instructor. At that time THL will offer Student employment as a flight instructor at THL.

Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

1. This Agreement shall be structured in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida, U.S.A.
2. The parties may submit any dispute or controversy arising out of this Agreement for arbitration, any such arbitration shall take place in Tallahassee, FL, U.S.A.

Student hereby asserts that Student is of lawful age and legally competent to sign this Agreement or that Student has acquired the written consent of Student's parent or guardian. If underage, such consent must be attached to this Agreement.

Student understands that the terms herein are contractual and not merely recital, and that Student has signed this Agreement on Student's own free act and with the knowledge that Student hereby waives Student's legal rights. Student further agrees if any provision(s) of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that such provision(s) may be severed from this Agreement; however the remainder of this Agreement shall then be construed as though the unenforceable provision had never been contained therein.

I, BY THIS INSTRUMENT, AGREE TO EXEMPT AND RELEASE MY INSTRUCTORS, THL AND ALL RELATED ENTITIES AS DEFINED ABOVE FROM ALL LIABILITY OR RESPONSIBILITY WHATSOEVER FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH HOWEVER CAUSED, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES, WHETHER PASSIVE OR ACTIVE.

I HAVE FULLY INFORMED MYSELF OF AND UNDERSTAND THE CONTENTS OF THIS AGREEMENT BEFORE I SIGNED IT ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND MY HEIRS.
